

Celebrating OA's 61st birthday (Jan 19, 1960)

To celebrate OA's 61st birthday, it's a great time to announce that Historic recordings of Rozanne S., founder of OA, are now available from the Podcasts page What a treat!

In the 1999 recording, "Reflections: A Visit with OA's Founder," Rozanne opens up about her life and lengthy journey toward becoming the founder of OA. She chronicles how she guided the carrying of OA's message around the world. Listen as she recounts with enthusiasm, humor, and joy about the inauspicious-yet-aspirational beginnings of OA, which were shaped by the powers of human connection and compromise.

In 2003, "And Now a Word from Our Founder" was published as a compilation of five of Rozanne's keynote speeches at World Service Business Conferences in 1994, 1997, 1998, 2000, and 2001. In them, Rozanne speaks with her characteristic humor and candid humility on such subjects as the origins of OA's Traditions, the importance of principles before personalities, and complicated issues of empathy and sacrifice. Let yourself be inspired as she ends her addresses with an audibly passionate call for the delegates—and the Fellowship at large—to engage in greater acts of service on behalf of OA.



I put my hand in yours, and together we can do what we could never do alone. No longer is there a sense of hopelessness, no longer must we each depend upon our own unsteady willpower. We are all together now, reaching out our hands for power and strength greater than ours, and as we join hands, we find love and understanding beyond our wildest dreams.
